

RoHS Directive 2015/863/EU

To Whom It May Concern,

This Directive has been in force since 2015 and is aimed at eradicating certain hazardous substances from new electrical and electronic equipment. Brett Martin fully endorses the guiding principles of the legislation and is committed to ensuring that our products are compliant with the regulations where appropriate.

All rigid PVC (flat sheet, corrugated sheet, pipes, profiles and foam sheet), PMMA, PC (flat, hard-coat, corrugated and multi-wall), PET-G and PS products and their associated packaging are compliant with this legislation, containing none of the materials listed.

The restricted substances outlined:

Lead (Pb): < 1000 ppm **Mercury (Hg):** <100 ppm **Cadmium (Cd):** <100 ppm

Hexavalent Chromium (Cr VI): <1000 ppm **Polybrominated Biphenyls (PBB):** <1000 ppm

Polybrominated Diphenyl Ethers (PBDE): < 1000 ppm Bis(2-Ethylhexyl) Phthalate (DEHP): < 1000 ppm Benzyl Butyl Phthalate (BBP): < 1000 ppm

Dibutyl Phthalate (DBP): < 1000 ppm Diisobutyl Phthalate (DIBP): < 1000 ppm
